PICKLEBALL PROGRAM SIGN UP

Club members may sign up for program sessions up to 7 days in advance by registering online starting at 7:30am. Please note that the new booking system for 2023 has an automatic system for clearing a waitlist if a space becomes available.

All program cost are \$9.00 plus HST.

Programs and program times are subject to change based on demand.

- Players may be invited up to play at a higher level by our club evaluators.
- Players can play down a level if spaces are available 72 hours in advance.
- Players must maintain their club level.

For the social player. A great opportunity to meet new players and have fun. Players registering for the Social programs must know the basics of the game, serve, return, positioning and scoring. Please be sure to respect the level of your opponent for all Social programs. No Club Rating is required for Social players. Players with a club Rating 3.0 and higher may only sign up for the Mixed Social All Level Program on Wednesday and Friday.

PICKLEBALL LEAGUES

Sign ups for League play only will begin online or by calling in starting January 02. Registration closes January 21, 2023. League is pre-paid

- League cost includes organization, scoring, prizes and refreshments at the Café after the last game
- Minimum players required is 20 and maximum players is 25.
- League format will be groups of 5 (changed weekly), each player plays twice with each player, scores recorded and tallied weekly. Schedule to be provided.
- Exception: Dill Pickle League will be partner play for the first hour then social play for the second. Players can sign up in partners or as singles. Single registrations will be matched with a partner.

HOW TO GET RATED?

We offer programs for all members pending your level of play. When players request a Club Rating it is based on required shots for that level. The rating is based on how consistently a player performs the required shots to play in a certain level during game situations. Please review the requirements for a level prior to a Club Rating.

Please note that all Mixed Socials, All Level Socials and Ladies 2.5, do not require a club rating. We recognize that some members, no matter their skill set prefer to play in the social programs only.

THE PURPOSE:

The purpose of rated programs is to ensure a consistent and competitive level of play for all players in that program as much as possible. We will have a call up system as well for players close to the next level for 2023.

If you are currently not Club Rated and are considering playing in any program level 3.0 and above, please contact our Pickleball Coordinator (sscarfone@greenhillslondon.com) to set up a time for the evaluation.

HOW TO GET RATED:

Rating times will be set 2 to 3 times monthly for each level and advance sign ups will be required. Once an evaluation is requested, players will be preevaluated at no cost in their current level. Some exceptions may/will apply. If players do not receive a level there is a two month waiting time to try again.

Note, a rating is not permanent. The level you receive must be maintained and hopefully improved upon. We are often evaluating in programs and players will be contacted if skills no longer meet that level they have obtained. Please note that if you have been away from a level for a period of time, that you do have the skills required when you come back in for the enjoyment of the other members. Players can play down a level to work on their skills if needed. Please contact our club coordinator for this exception.

Please do not register for a program that you are not currently rated for before you have a Club Rating. Players registered without a Club Rating will be removed and contacted by our Pickleball Co-Coordinator.

WHO EVALUATES:

Our Club evaluators are either a Pro Level Coach or CRS (Certified Rating Specialist). We take this seriously as we know levels are very important to the player. If you are looking to enter a tournament, be confident to enter in the level which you are club rated. Tournaments are a great way to develop your game when registering in your appropriate level.

RATING COST:

\$30.00 PER PLAYER for Club Rating which covers the game evaluations (3 games minimum) and written report outlining your individual strengths and areas for improvement. The court fee is additional cost. Please note that this is for our Club purposes and is not an official rating.

PRIVATE LESSON

Our coaches specialize in coaching beginners through to advanced levels. Members can arrange a set time outside of clinic times with one of our coaches for a private lesson for 1 to 4 players. Members can book courts as per the regular booking privileges (up to one week in advance). Please confirm pricing with your coach.

PICKLEBALL COURT ETIQUETTE

- Players are to arrive at their court only at their designated time. Players are to make their last serve with 5 minutes remaining and be off courts with belongings by booking end time.
- Players to travel to/from court quietly
- Franklin X balls to be used in programs and are included by Club

Outside of programs, there is multiple time options available from 8am to 8pm start time for members to book their own personal court for two hours. Courts are available to book 7 days in advance starting at 730am. Cost is \$9.00 per person plus HST (minimum 4 players). One hour court bookings will be available on court 5A all day cost is \$9.00 per person (minimum 2 players)
